



OUR OBJECTIVE

TKO Structure is committed to helping our clients reach their design and building goals in the most efficient way possible.

To that end, we've created a Design+Build process that helps to insure that your ideas are communicated in as clear a manner as possible. This will hopefully lead to a finished product we can both be proud of.

To help aid facilitate this process, we've set up a quick summary that outlines our Design+Build process in 3 steps.

PHASES

- 1. Initial Meeting, Consultation and Estimate
- 2. Plans and Proposal
- 3. Design, Fabrication & Building

INITIAL MEETING, CONSULTATION, ROUGH ESTIMATE

An initial meeting, whether by email or phone, or an onsite visit, whereupon a good idea of your design objectives can be arrived at, will provide the necessary information to form an estimate.

A rough estimate is free of charge and is essentially a general cost assessment that would include all items relevant to the project.

DESIGN

If your project is more detailed and requires, sketches, shop drawings, 3-D renderings and/or plans suitable for permits, a design fee would be required in advance.

Submittable plans and/or obtaining building permits will require a retainer from which to draw incurred hourly work and/or expenses, i.e. plan fees, licenses, etc. Retainers start at \$1,000. or up to 5% total estimated budget, whichever is greater, with services billed against the retainer. Any unused retainer will be credited towards the work.

Client agrees to augment retainer if/when needed.

DESIGN FEES

Drawings/Designs: \$75. hr. or Negotiated fee Building Department Plans/Permitting: \$75. hr. + Fees Engineering: Per hr. basis: TBD or Negotiated fee Soils Investigation: Per hr. basis: TBD or Negotiated fee Consultation/Travel: \$75. hr.

FINAL CONTRACT

This provides the client with full, comprehensive details of all aspects of the project including materials, working methods as well as a close approximation of the time required to finish the project

FABRICATION, BUILDING

After the contract has been signed and agreed to by both parties, and payment has been collected, we will calendar the work and commence with the process of fabrication, installation and/or building.

COMPENSATION SCHEDULE

DEPOSIT FEE

If the Proposal is in-line with your budget and you would like to move forward with us as your builder, a non-refundable deposit payment is required to secure a scheduled commencement date and/or commencement of ordering of materials, fabrication, etc.

GENERAL FEES

Payments are to made at beginning and at progress interval(s), with final payment after completion of project.
